- Bachelor's degree (4 yrs)
- Medical school (4 yrs)
- One year internship
- Three years of residency working alongside experienced doctors and completing 12,000 to 16,000 hours of patient treatment
- Obtain medical license to practice
- · Become board certified by completing an exam on knowledge and skills
